On steep NW facing ground and bisected by minor road, NE/SW. Above the road is rich oakwood, with old beech (<i>Fagus sylvatica</i>) stands along the upper edge – both regenerating very well. Upper boundary includes an old track/tramway, with gulley/earthwork as shown on map. The remaining upper boundary is an intact fence. Roadbank communities are rich in forbs, ferns, etc.				
Below road is mostly recent, secondary woodland and colonising scrub developed within few old beech (<i>F. sylvatica</i>) and oak (<i>Quercus</i> spp.). Trees, shrubs and forbs are a rich variety of species but ash (<i>Fraxinus excelsior</i>) may dominate in medium term. Adjacent land includes pastures, roads, scrub, and housing.				
Altitude is c.180-230m. Lower part is enclosed partly within significant walls.
