

### FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE (including topography, adjacent land use, access and boundaries etc.):

This is a diverse site that occurs on sloping valley side down to and including a significant stream. It varies from open bilberry (Vaccinium myrtillus) heath through valley side mires and wet woodland, down to mature beech (Fagus sylvatica) stands. The site is largely enclosed by walls with some fencing but the main area of heath is open to grazing from above.

Access is achieved from the track that runs north/south up Cwm Celyn, across a field and the stream. An old gate entry point was also present. Access may also be possible from the farm on the high ground to the NW. Fields to the east are grazed and used for hay/silage. Land to the north and west, is grazed moor with some large trees and shrubs, whilst housing is close to the south.

Altitude is c.350-450m
