FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE (including topography, adjacent land use, access and boundaries etc.):				
The main block is primarily oak ( <i>Quercus</i> spp.) woodland facing South, but the site includes a minor North-South valley running towards the farm above. Regeneration is widely present, despite some grazing, with locally dense thickets of young birch ( <i>Betula</i> spp.) and beech ( <i>Fagus sylvatica</i> ).				
Ground floras are generally quite rich, but locally very grassy – wavy hair grass in parts and acidic pasture in the minor valley. Two old quarries are present; the one towards the East supporting U1-type communities and gorse ( <i>Ulex</i> spp.) scrub on quarry waste. Boundaries are fenced, but not kept in good repair. Adjacent land – pastures above, housing and road below.
