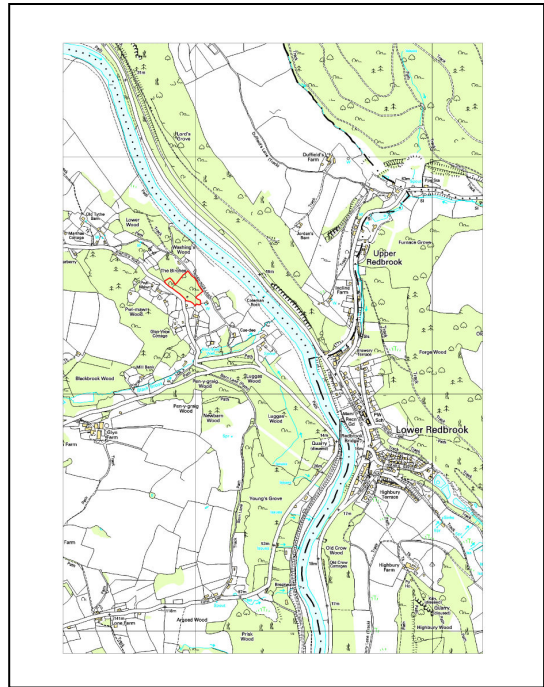

FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE (including topography, adjacent land use, access and boundaries etc.):

This is an area of Broad-leaved Woodland that lies on sloping land (north-east facing) between two roads (Birches Road to the south-west and Washings Lane to the north-east). The woodland also borders houses and associated gardens on its most north-easterly end. At its north-westerly end it largely borders an area of similar woodland (not surveyed as owner could not be contacted to get permission). The woodland is not entirely stock-proof but given the bordering habitat does not need to be. Over the south-western part of the woodland (Area 1) the canopy is complete with a strong Birch (*Betula sp.*) and Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) element, the north-eastern part (Area 2) is much more open however. The understorey is quite well developed with Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) being the most noticeable component. The Hazel has been recently coppiced in the more open north-eastern part (Area 2). The ground flora is reasonably diverse with carpets of Bluebells (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) present throughout much of the wood, with Yellow Archangel (*Lamium galeobdolon*) a prominent component also. The more open north-eastern part (Area 2) has a less typical woodland flora as elements of grassland flora are also present and in parts Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus sp.*) and Bracken (*Pteridium aquilinum*) are abundant.

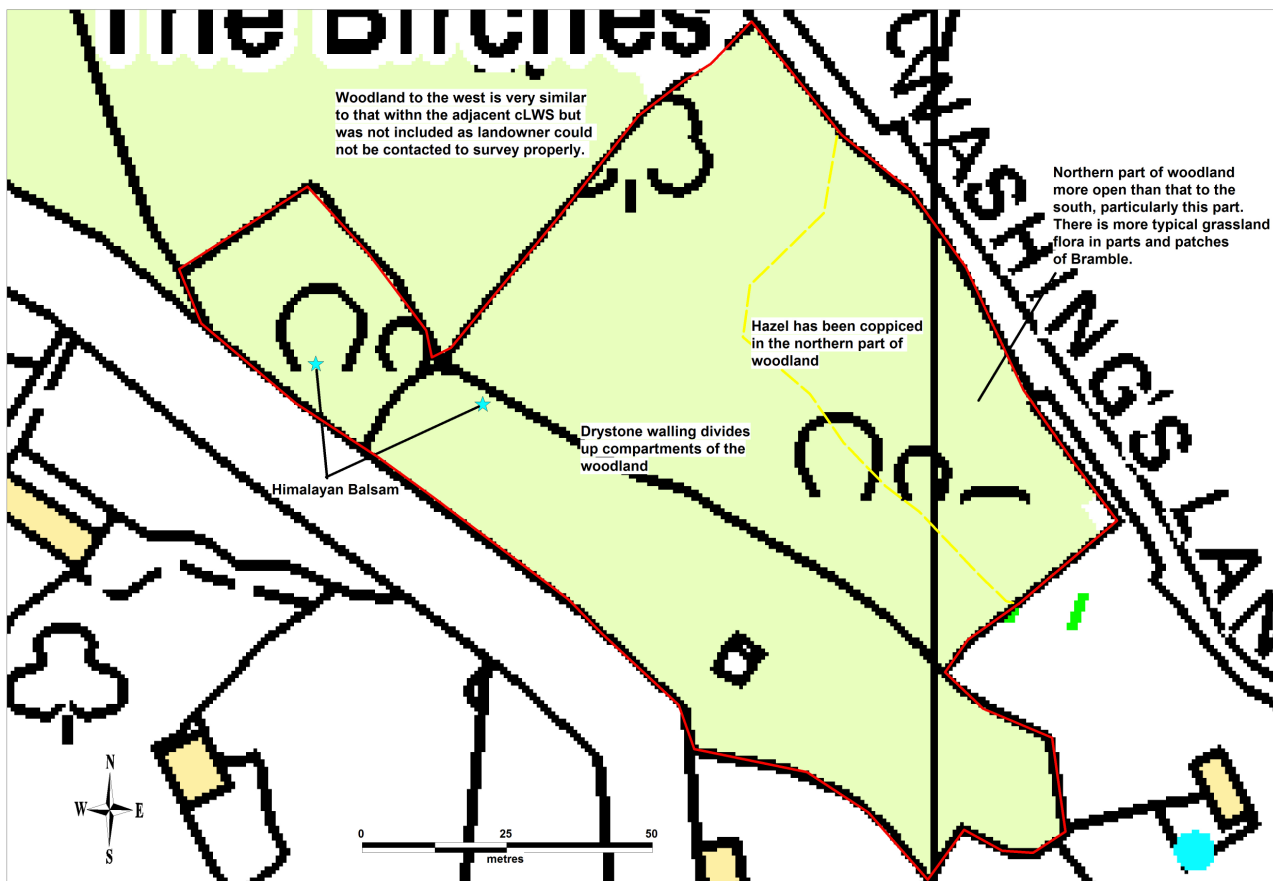
