FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE (including topography, adjacent land use, access and boundaries etc.):

This is a small remnant orchard. The orchard is overgrown, rough grassland that slopes downwards to the south and is surrounded by a mix of hedgerow and tree-line. The grass is rank with patches of Nettle, Bracken and Thistles but Bramble has not yet taken over. Sheep occasionally enter the orchard but this would appear to be infrequent. Any herbs present in the grassland are largely smothered by rank grass but Hogweed, Creeping Thistle, Marsh Thistle and Nettle are conspicuous. A few more valuable indicator species persist including Knapweed, Lesser Stitchwort, Red Clover, Meadow Vetchling and Catsear. Most of the original orchard trees are dead and gone. There is one very large Cherry tree with lots of veteran tree features and two veteran plums (one dead and one alive). It is these three trees that provide much of the wildlife value for this site. As well as these trees there are two mid-age Apples, a few mid-age Damsons as well as a younger Apple, Plum and sprouting Damsons.




