FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE (including topography, adjacent land use, access and boundaries etc.):								
This is a roughly square orchard that slopes downwards to the south. It is grassy and has reasonable species diversity with Common Knapweed ( <i>Centaurea nigra</i> ) being locally frequent and other species such as Agrimony ( <i>Agrimonia eupatoria</i> ), Meadowsweet ( <i>Filipendula ulmaria</i> ), Catsear ( <i>Hypochaeris</i>								

This is a roughly square orchard that slopes downwards to the south. It is grassy and has reasonable species diversity with Common Knapweed (*Centaurea nigra*) being locally frequent and other species such as Agrimony (*Agrimonia eupatoria*), Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Catsear (*Hypochaeris radicata*), Red Bartsia (*Odontites verna*) and Imperforate St. Johns Wort (*Hypericum imperforatum*) present amongst others. The most species rich area is in the vicinity of a small stream near the southern corner. The site is surrounded by mature hedgerows/tree-lines. There are three areas of Giant Rhubarb (*Gunnera* sp.) in the field. The fruit trees are Apples and Pears, many of the fruit trees of the orchard have been lost historically with just 14 left of which 4 have many veteran tree features, the others not being as old. There are a further 3 dead trees still present. The remaining trees are largely situated around the perimeter of the field with the centre open.




