

FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE	(including topography, adj	acent land use, access and boundaries etc.):		
This orchard was part of a larger orchard that has been divided very recently into three separate parts with the middle section under new ownership/management. As a consequence this area has been assessed separately. The orchard is rectangular in shape and bordered by species rich hedgerows on all sides. It slopes downwards to the north and the grassland is improved and had not been grazed very recently but it is likely that it is at times. There are many Apple and Pear trees of veteran status with a mix of living, half dead, dead standing and dead fallen specimens. Many of these veteran trees have crevices and dead wood in the canopy and a number are hollow. Dead wood has been left in-situ and in places has been overgrown by Brambles. Approximately 60 new Apple & Pear trees have been planted, these are principally on the sparsely wooded central and western area Orchard: 5 or more cultivated fruit or nut trees, crown edges no more than 20m apart – Y Being of a traditional structure which may currently be or have been managed in a traditional way - Y Old trees plus two of the following - Y Standing deadwood - Y Fallen deadwood - Y Cavities - Y				


