FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE	(including to	onography ad	iacent land use, access and boundaries etc.):

The orchard is just a remnant. It is within two sometimes sheep grazed fields that are not particularly species rich and have patches of rush (Juncus sp.) and Tufted Hair-grass (Deschampsia cespitosa). The fields are flanked by a mix of fencing, woodland and old hedgerow. The hedgerow that divides the two fields is defunct. The fields are generally flat, sloping gently downwards to the east. Not many fruit trees remain with only evidence of ten (Pear, Apple & Damson) between the two fields of which three are dead. All the trees are veteran however with much evidence of veteran tree features in the form of cavities and dead wood. Dead wood is also left on the ground and the Apples have much Mistletoe (Viscum album). The number of living fruit trees in the more southerly field are very few and they are spread out to such a degree that it could be argued that only the more northerly field should be a LWS but both fields have been included as they form a single orchard unit (refer to Sketch Map).

- 5 or more cultivated fruit or nut trees, crown edges no more than 20m apart Y

 - Standing deadwood Y


