Roughly oblong, it slopes gently northeastwards with higher ground on the western side. The field is bounded on the east by tall hedgerow and external track, to the north by a post & wire fence, and elsewhere by tall hedgerow. The herb-rich sward occurs on the higher ground to the west with Potentilla erecta, Euphrasia officinalis, Danthonia decumbens, Trifolium medium, Stachys officinalis, Succisa pratensis, Carex flacca, Veronica officinalis & Pedicularis palustris. An area of M23 characterised by Juncus sp., Lychnis flos-cuculi & Ranunculus flammula occurs on the southern & northern edge of the field. The sward appears lightly grazed. The eastern half of the field is agriculturally modified with Lolium perenne & Cynosurus cristatus more frequent. The grassland here is a mosaic of tightly grazed and taller, coarser grasses with some herbs. Thistles & docks occur within this half of the field.	H4 Neutral Grassland
