WS/SO32/03	Pen-y-pye Meadow	SO395231	1.57 ha	Semi Improved Neutral Grassland (MG5/6)	Species Rich Grassland (HAP)	<p>A nice species rich neutral meadow located c.4km south of Pontrilias, with locally frequent patches of <i>Trisetum flavescens</i>, frequent and well distributed <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> and <i>Stellaria graminea</i> and <i>Centaurea nigra</i>. <i>Trifolium pratense</i>, <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> and <i>Hypochoeris radicata</i> are occasional through the sward and <i>Dactylorhiza fuchsii</i> are locally frequent towards the south and east of the site. <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> invasion is quite heavy at the south margin, encroaching onto the areas where <i>Dactylorhiza fuchsii</i> is found. The site has a slight north west facing slope and is separately by a track to a continuation of the meadow. This area to the south of the track is of reduced species richness and <i>Lolium</i> is a frequent part of the sward. However <i>Lotus corniculatus</i>, <i>Centaurea nigra</i> are occasional throughout. A locally separate plant community exists on the trackway and small stony bank to the south of the track with occasional <i>Agrimonia eupatoria</i>, <i>Ononis repens</i>, <i>Pilosella officinarum</i>, <i>Potentilla erecta</i> and <i>Lotus corniculatus</i>.</p>	H4 Neutral Grasslands
