Quality indicators are frequent throughout the sward, especially <i>Centaurea nigra</i> , <i>Hypochoeris radicata</i> and <i>Succisa pratensis</i> . <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> , <i>Trifolium pratense</i> and <i>Vicia cracca</i> also occasional - frequent. Thick hedgerow with standard trees is present at the site's southern edge and a patch of thick deciduous woodland abuts the site at its south east corner. A stone wall and line of Scots Pine is present in the vicinity of the church building and a newly constructed area for car parking is located in the north west corner of the site.
