WS/SO32/06	Little Goytre	SO352236	3.24 ha	Neutral Grassland - Species Rich MG5	Lowland Species-Rich Grassland (HAP)	5 Fields and a small orchard adjacent to Little Goytre on a north-west facing moderate to steep slope. Fields 1 to 4 are sheep grazed with a very close/short sward. Field 1 comprises locally frequent, but well scattered <i>Colchicum autumnale</i> from the NE to the SW corner. Other indicators are locally occasional, such as <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> and <i>Potentilla erecta</i> . Field 2 was similarly very short grazed. A slightly higher number of indicators were locally frequent, including <i>Cardamine pratensis</i> , <i>Luzula campestris</i> , <i>Leontodon sp</i> , <i>Centaurea nigra</i> and <i>Hypochaeris radicata</i> . No <i>Colchicum</i> present. Field 3 was more steeply sloping, slightly less short grazed rough pasture. <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> and Rushes had been recently topped. Along the north eastern edge <i>Potentilla erecta</i> was locally frequent and <i>Stellaria graminea</i> and <i>Succisa pratensis</i> occurred rarely. Field 4 was less intensively grazed but <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> is frequent/locally abundant throughout hawthorn scrub. <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> and <i>Stellaria graminea</i> were locally occasional. Field 5 was ungrazed at time of survey, sward height 20cm, low herb grass ratio, grass lush and dark green, but <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> LF, <i>Galium saxatile</i> and <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i> LO.
