The site is just under one acres and it has a steep north westerly facing slope. The grassland is damp in places and <i>Juncus articulatus</i> can be found in the north western corner with <i>Ajuga reptans</i> , <i>Cardamins pratensis</i> and <i>Fillipendula ulmaria</i> . <i>Dactylorhiza fuchsii</i> are scattered throughout with <i>Succisa pratensis</i> and <i>Betonica officinalis</i> in placed. The field has a stream running down the north western boundary that has some scrub associated that joins a small patch of broadleaved woodland at the northern end. A road borders the south and western boundary separated by a tall thick hedge. The grassland is currently cut 4 times a year and an appropriate management scheme ideally needs to put in place.
