Sedges are also frequent in the wetter area, with Filipendula ulmria & Pulicaria dysenterica. The sward is coarse & tussocky throughout the drier areas with much dead thatch. This meadow is bordered by thick hedgerows on all sides except to the south where it is open to the church car park and to the Church Farm barn. Field 2 is similar and bounded on all sides by hedges, but is poorer in species-diversity and indicator species. South & east of these meadows are a series of species-rich grassland and a CWS.
