There are 2 north-facing fields: one below the house, and the second to the west. The latter has a spring & flush running down it to the brook. The south-facing fields are interspersed with areas of woodland, and there is some alder-woodland along the brook. An artificial lake lies in the valley bottom. Prior to the new owners, the site had been heavily grazed by sheep, but now the site is part of Tir Gofal and was fenced off from woodland areas in Nov 2005. The grasslands do support a wide diversity of meadow grasses and other plants including <i>Campanula rotundifolia</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Luzula campestris</i> & <i>Crepis capillaris</i> . The site is owned by an active member of MMG who is very keen to manage her land for wildlife. The fields are now grazed by sheep, alpacas & horses. The more eastern parts of the woodland are recorded in the AWI.	H20 Mosaic Habitats
