Species present include <i>Centaurea nigra, Thymus pulegioides,</i> <i>Stellaria graminea, Luzula campestris</i> & <i>Ranunculus bulbosus. Thymus</i> is present in the eastern half of the site, with stands of U4b found to the west with more shade-tolerant species such as <i>Stachys betonica</i> & <i>Viola riviniana.</i> There are also records from the owners of <i>Platanthera chlorantha</i> , although none has been seen in this area below the old track for some years.
