It comprises moderately steep-sloping fields of varying aspect. The fields contain semi-improved grassland, bordered by tall nonstockproof hedgerows with trees. The higher drier fields support MG5; U1 is confined to the highest field and the wetter ground has a M23/MG5 mosiac. Marginal vegetation of Rubus fruticosus, Crataegus monogyna & Pteridium aquilinium occurs especially on the fields NE of Allt-y-Bela. The MG5 sward includes Festuca rubra, Anthoxanthum odoratum, Centaurea nigra, Lotus comiculatus, Carex flacca, Plantago lanceolata & Pimpinella saxifraga; Potentilla erecta, Succissa pratensis & Danthonia decumbens are indicative of an MG5c community. The lowest northern fields contain anthills with Thymus pulegioides, Genista tinctoria & Danthonia decumbens.  Many old tracks within the site have herb-rich flora including Linum catharticum, Hieracium pilosella & Leontodon taraxacoides. Wetter areas of M23 contain Lotus uliginosus, Carex ovalis & Pedicularis sylvatica. This continues eastwards from the streams at Cwrt-y-Bela. Lolium is rare throughout and indicates lower levels of improvement. Management is restricted to low levels of grazing due to lack of stock-proofing.
