A roughly circular field in outline, it lies on a moderate NE facing slope, it is enclosed by tall over grown hedgerow with trees & woodland. The surrounding grassland is primarily improved grassland. The field supports wet and dry grassland due to the nature of the drainage. The drier grassland has a species-rich sward of <i>Luzula campestris</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Carex flacca</i> & <i>Centaurea nigra</i> . The wetter grassland supports an M23 community with <i>Juncus acutiflorus/articulatus</i> , <i>Juncus inflexus</i> , <i>Galium palustre</i> , <i>Lotus pedunculatus</i> , <i>Ranunculus flammula</i> & <i>Potentilla anserina</i> . Bramble scrub encroaches on the field from all sides and the boundaries are all un-stockproof	H7 Marshy Grassland
