Moderately sloping field, facing north-west. Damp/marshy grassland, comprising abundant <i>Filipendula ulmaria</i> and <i>Angelica sylvestris</i> , <i>Centaurea nigra</i> and <i>Juncus articulatus</i> , locally frequent <i>Dactylorhiza fuchsii</i> , <i>Ajuga reptans</i> , <i>Alchemilla vulgaris</i> , <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> , <i>Lysimachia nummularia</i> , <i>Potentilla reptans</i> . Occasional <i>Lychnis flos-cuculi</i> , <i>Vicia cracca</i> , <i>Primula vulgaris</i> , <i>Equisetum</i> spp. Field edges comprising locally frequent bracken, bramble, and willow scrub. Sward height approx. 40-50cm. Stream runs along north-eastern edge of field. Owners are keen on wildlife management and are Gwent Wildlife Trust members. The field is grazed by sheep occasionally.
