There is an old ménage area that has developed into species-rich grassland with numerous Common Spotted Orchids (Dactylorhiza fuschii) and a pond close by this. Near the road next to a mown lawn is an orchard where grass has been allowed to grow and Pignut (Conopodium majus), Bluebells (Hyacinthoides non-scripta), Germander Speedwell (Veronica chamaedrys), various fine meadow grasses, Field Woodrush (Luzula campestris) and Red Clover (Trifolium pratense) were frequent there. Another orchard has been planted at the ower edge of the top field. The fields were previously (prior to current owner) grazed by horses. The whole area has considerable wildlife interest. Many indicator species (good species-rich meadow plants) are present, notably Southern Ladies Mantle (Alchemilla filicaulis), Common Spotted Orchids and Bird's-foot Trefoil (Lotus comiculatus). Butterflies, dragonflies, small and large mammals utilise the grassland and woodland edge. Around the pond were Marsh Marigold (Caltha palustris), Lesser Spearwort (Ranunculus flammula), Water Mint (Mentha aquatic) and in the water Marestail (Hippuris vulgaris), Bogbean (Menyanthes trifoliate), Lesser Duckweed (Lemna minor) and Canadian Pondweed (Elodea canadensis). Grassland Area: The four main field compartments have between 5 – 8 Neutral indicator species. There is however 16 different Neutral indicator species in the areas combined.
