	Trewyn, Llanishen	SO475029	3.05 ha	Species Rich Grassland		<p>The whole grassland area covers approximately 3 hectares and the fields slope down from the road to the west. There is an old ménage area that has developed into species-rich grassland with numerous Common Spotted Orchids (<i>Dactylorhiza fuschii</i>) and a pond close by this. Near the road next to a mown lawn is an orchard where grass has been allowed to grow and Pignut (<i>Conopodium majus</i>), Bluebells (<i>Hyacinthoides non-scripta</i>), Germander Speedwell (<i>Veronica chamaedrys</i>), various fine meadow grasses, Field Woodrush (<i>Luzula campestris</i>) and Red Clover (<i>Trifolium pratense</i>) were frequent there. Another orchard has been planted at the ower edge of the top field. The fields were previously (prior to current owner) grazed by horses.</p> <p>The whole area has considerable wildlife interest. Many indicator species (good species-rich meadow plants) are present, notably Southern Ladies Mantle (<i>Alchemilla filicaulis</i>), Common Spotted Orchids and Bird's-foot Trefoil (<i>Lotus corniculatus</i>). Butterflies, dragonflies, small and large mammals utilise the grassland and woodland edge. Around the pond were Marsh Marigold (<i>Caltha palustris</i>), Lesser Spearwort (<i>Ranunculus flammula</i>), Water Mint (<i>Mentha aquatic</i>) and in the water Marestalk (<i>Hippuris vulgaris</i>), Bogbean (<i>Menyanthes trifoliata</i>), Lesser Duckweed (<i>Lemna minor</i>) and Canadian Pondweed (<i>Elodea canadensis</i>).</p> <p><i>Grassland Area: The four main field compartments have between 5 – 8 Neutral indicator species. There is however 16 different Neutral indicator species in the areas combined.</i></p>	H4) Neutral Grassland – Have neutral grassland with more than 8 indicator species (16 Species over whole site but no more than 8 in a field).
