

Extension to Hilston Park LWS – to include woodland (Steve Heaton, 23/7/12/2012)

Site description – Hilston Park Woodland (0.79 ha)

The current LWS at Hilston Park is a species rich grassland with species such as *Briza media*, *Danthonia decumbens*, *Neottia ovata*, and *Dactylorhiza fuchsiae*. The proposed extension is the adjoining woodland.

The woodland has a stream running its length and some ponds the woodland slopes down a valley towards the northwest there are steep rocky areas stream gullies and level areas all adding to the ground flora diversity. The majority of the canopy is made up of *Fraxinus excelsior* other tree species including *Alnus glutinosa*, *Tilia cordata*, *Ulmus glabra* and *Acer pseudoplatanus*. The ground flora is quite dense with abundant *Urtica dioica* and *Rubus fruticosus* other frequent species include *Anemone nemerosa*, *Mercurialis perennis*, *Ribes uva-crispa*, *Adoxa moschatellina*, *Primula vulgaris* and *Carex sylvatica*.


Throughout the woodland there are several potentially invasive species these are; Japanese Knotweed (*Fallopian japonica*), Cherry Laurel (*Prunus laurocerasus*) Portuguese laurel (*Prunus lusitanica*) and Rhododendron.

The woodland meets LWS criteria because it has 14 well spread indicator species as, streams wet flushes, ponds, sunken lanes, and dry stone walls.
