WS/SO41/11	Summer House Field	SO459134	1.3 ha	Neutral Grassland (MG5) Scrub	Species-rich Grassland (HAP)	A remnant piece of grassland located south of the main house at the Rolls Of Monmouth Golf Club. The original field boundaries are lost within dense thorn scrub; the site is only accessible from the main track to the north. The field gently slopes southward and contains unspoilt anthills amongst scattered scrub and a mosaic of tall & short herbaceous vegetation. There are signs of recent grazing; deer and rabbits were seen during the visit. The sward is herb-rich with <i>Agrimonia eupatoria</i> , <i>Senecio erucifolius</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Luzula campestris</i> , <i>Ranunculus bulbosus</i> & <i>Carex flacca</i> . The diminutive fern <i>Ophiglossum vulgatum</i> was locally frequent amongst the shorter tightly grazed vegetation along the eastern side of the site. Scrub is encroaching from all sides and management is required to address the loss of a valuable parcel of grassland.	H4 Neutral Grassland
