The field is bounded to the north & east by barbed wire fencing, to the east by a hedge, and the west by broadleaved woodland. The surrounding land-use is a mix of arable, improved grassland and orchard.</p> <p>The grassland consists of a mixture of species-rich MG6 and MG5. The sward is variable in height with shorter grazed turf closer to the woodland edge with a species-rich assemblage of <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i>, <i>Galium verum</i>, <i>Succisa pratensis</i>, <i>Stachys officinalis</i>, <i>Luzula campestris</i>, <i>Centaurea nigra</i> and <i>Potentilla erecta</i>. Species-richness of the field is greatest below the public footpath. The sward has an appearance of having been undergrazed with a significant amount of dead vegetation amongst the regrowth of coarser grasses. Rabbit activity has helped the grazing activities on the site.</p>	H7 Neutral Grassland
