

## Extension to Little Mill Farm WS /SO41/14 - to include woodland (Steve Heaton 21/9/12 )

### Owner details

### Site description - Little Mill Farm Woodland ( 1.14 ha) SO 425 175

The new area of woodland joins the existing two areas of grassland LWS at Little Mill Farm. The woodland has areas of ash oak woodland and wet alder woodland and would best be described as semi natural ancient wood. A stream runs through the length of the woodland the woodland is on both sides.

Although the canopy is very dense, the woodland has a very good ground flora in all but the most heavily shaded areas where ferns are abundant. Within the woodland lies an old mill and associated workings, including an old silt filled leat and stone walling and medieval sunken lane.

Along the stream *Alnus glutinosa* is the abundant species in the canopy. In other areas *Fraxinus excelsior* and *Corylus avellana* are more common. Other species in the canopy include *Crataegus monogyna*, *Quercus robur*, *Acer campestre* and *Salix* sp.

Although it was late in the season when this woodland was surveyed, there were signs of the presence of *Allium ursinum* and *Anemone nemerosa*. *Chrysosplenium oppositifolium* is frequent along the stream and in the wetter areas also frequent is *Deschampsia caespitose*, a common plant of W7 wet alder woodlands. Other species present include, *Lamium galeobdolon*, *Lysimachia nemorum*, *Polystichum setiferum*, and *Oxalis acetosa*.

This woodland also has two fairly uncommon plants of Monmouthshire *Carex strigosa* and *Dipsacus pilosus*.

Possibly the woodland would benefit from small scale rotational coppicing.


