The field as a whole is bordered by tall overgrown hedgerow of mixed species with broadleaved woodland to the east. The surrounding land use is essentially agriculturally modified grassland. Wildlife site interest is centred on the herb-rich east facing slope down in the woodland which contains MG5 association of <i>Succisa pratensis</i>, <i>Centaurea nigra</i>, <i>Lotus corniculatus</i>, <i>Potentilla anglica</i>, <i>Carex flacca</i> and <i>Carex caryophylla</i>. <i>Juncus</i> sp. occur throughout the sward. The base of the slope is floristically less interesting and trees and scrub have begun encroaching from the adjacent woodland. The rest of the field is flatter and consists of species-poor MG6 grassland with frequent <i>Lolium</i> and <i>Trifolium repens</i>.</p>	H7 Neutral Grasslands
