There was scattered bracken throughout. Field 2 was on higher ground, with moderate/gentle slopes facing south and west. Species present here included frequent <i>Lotus</i> <i>corniculatus, Centaurea nigra, Festuca</i> <i>rubra, Potentilla erecta</i> , occasional/locally frequent <i>Briza</i> <i>media, Genista tinctoria, Carex</i> <i>panicea, Stellaria graminea, Lathyrus</i> <i>pratensis, Vicia cracca</i> .
