WS/SO41/19	Pant-Y-Pwll	SO448140	5.41 ha	SI Neutral Grassland (MG5+6) Marshy Grassland (M23) Bracken Scrub	Species-rich Grasslands (HAP)	Collection of small fields on undulating ground north of and leading down to the River Trothy, which support a mixture of neutral grassland, scrub woodland and bracken, and small marsh areas that together represent a good wildlife resource. The grassland is of various condition and richness reflecting presence/absence of management. Field 1 has been recovered from scrub invasion by the owner and supports an interesting rich flora that includes well spread <i>Agrimonia eupatoria</i> , <i>Stellaria graminea</i> and <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> . Rare <i>Silaum silaus</i> in wetter area at west. Fields 2+3 present a mix of woodland/scrub with small open grassland patches and a remnant sward in places under the canopy. Overall a good variety of species including <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i> , <i>Agrimonia eupatoria</i> , <i>Stachys officinalis</i> , <i>Succisa pratensis</i> though not frequently distributed. Fields 6+7: Hay meadows with herbs though not immense in variety, all well distributed. Field 5: Also a meadow, supports good MG5 over slope adjoining a short regularly cut damp sward adjacent to River Trothy (rather species poor). Field 4 is very heavily encroached by bracken throughout and scrub at east. The centre of the site is impassable with <i>Cirsium arvense</i> and <i>Chamerion angustifolium</i> joining the bracken. However in limited open areas good variety of species is present and wetter vegetation towards the southern edge adds to the diversity. The site is enclosed by thick tall hedgerows.
