The steeper bank at the top of the slope was most diverse, comprising locally frequent/occasional <i>Potentilla erecta</i> , <i>Polygala serpyllifolia</i> , <i>Pedicularis sylvatica</i> , <i>Pilosella officinarum</i> , <i>Luzula campestris</i> , <i>Carex caryophyllea</i> , <i>Ranunculus bulbosus</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Plantago lanceolata</i> , <i>Trifolium repens</i> , <i>Trifolium dubium</i> , <i>Veronica officinalis</i> and <i>Vulpia bromoides</i> . Towards the lower, flatter part of the field the vegetation was more rank and semi-improved, floodplain meadow habitat, including locally frequent <i>Bromus hordeaceus</i> and <i>Lolium perenne</i> with a much taller sward height. On the upper parts of the slope there were frequent patches of dense bracken which could be a problem if left unmanaged.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
