Frequent scattered Bracken and occasional <i>Ulex gallii</i> and Hawthorn scrub, <i>Leontodon</i> spp, and <i>Viola</i> sp. Frequent localised patches of frequent <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Luzula campestris</i> , occasional <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i> , <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> , <i>Potentilla erecta</i> , <i>Potentilla sterilis</i> , <i>Stellaria graminea</i> , <i>Campanula rotundifolia</i> , <i>Carex panicea</i> . There is a cattle shed and a small pond with trees in the south-west corner. This area now comprises bare ground from cattle trampling. The boundary to adjacent field to west is not stockproof. There is a zigzag stone track across the field and the terrain is rocky and soils are thin. Was at one time an old quarry site.
