Caldicot Pill is a small area of limestone grassland with some scrub areas, one end is of less good quality and is quite rank. To the north there is a housing estate, with more houses to the west. The southern edge of the reserve is parallel to a railway line and to the east there is a playing field. The small 1 acre site is fairly flat with rough footpaths.
