Field 1 nearest New Grove is of similar quality. Similar grassland can be found to the north of the new driveway. Field 2 is also species rich but has much more of an acid feel. Other more neutral species can also be found. Both fields are surrounded by rich, thick hedges and are managed as New Grove with the landwoner being very keen in positively managing the fields. The fields have a gradual westerly facing slope and are bordered by B4293 on the eastern side, forestry to the north and improved pasture to the west. | H4 Neutral Grasslands |
