It comprises of 4 fields: Field 1 is cut for hay and is quite rich, although it becomes ranker towards the west. There is a mature pear tree at one end and a cesspit area which is dominated by ranker vegetation. The 2 fields behind the house to the west are horsegrazed quite tightly. A very small field on the other side of the drive is clearly species rich. Fields 3 and 4 are recommended for inclusion due to their diversity which would be clearer were they not horse grazed. Tall thick hedgerows surround the fields and the grassland is quite dry throughout. The Bauls Meadows lie adjacent to the north.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
