The site is quite small with a gentle easterly facing slope with a road lining the west and southern boundary. It is species rich. Although hay cut the sward is quite matted with a thatch and the site could do with some aftermath grazing. A dry stone wall surrounds the meadow with patches of hedgerow especially along the southern boundary. Tall trees line the northern boundary and a woodland flora can be found beneath this. A mature hawthorn is located along the northern boundary. Semi-improved fields lie adjacent to the south east (Ty-Cefn WS) with an improved field to the north.	H4 Neutral Grassland
