Cleared of brambles in 2004, it is now rabbit-grazed and stock-proof. The field lies adjacent to a recently planted broadleaved woodland (WGS) and to the west and south lie a mixture of ancient woodland, the Whitebrook and several ponds. Species in the field include <i>Polygala vulgaris</i> , <i>Primula veris</i> , <i>Carex caryophyllea</i> & <i>Betonica officinalis</i> . The cleared scrub around the edges is starting to return and several young broadleaved trees have been planted in the north-eastern corner. An arable field lies to the north.
