Fields 3 and 5 are the most species-rich having 12 indicator species. Species include <i>Centaurea nigra</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i> , <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> , <i>Hypochoeris radicata</i> , <i>Stellaria graminea</i> and <i>Luzula campestris</i> . Field 5 has <i>Hyacinthoides non-scripta</i> and <i>Narcissus pseudonarcissus</i> . The fields are sheltered, the boundaries are broken walls, fenced and mature trees. The lower slopes of the farm have been left un-managed for some time and is now 70% bracken to 30% neutral grassland.
