The main fields is MG5, species rich and includes <i>Centaurea nigra</i>, <i>Luzula campestris</i>, <i>Lotus corniculatus</i>, <i>Hypochoeris radicata</i>, <i>Stellaria graminea</i> and <i>Succisa pratensis</i>.</p> <p>Within this field (area 2) there is a marshy area (species rich grassland) surrounded by willow scrub (carr woodland). The marshy grassland has many species of sedge including <i>Carex acutiformis</i>, <i>Carex panicea</i>, <i>C. echinata</i>, <i>C. flacca</i>, <i>C. lavaegata</i>, and <i>C. lepidocarpa</i>. Other species include <i>Dactylorhiza praetermissa</i>, <i>Succisa pratensis</i>, <i>Viola palustris</i> and <i>Hydrocotyl vulgaris</i>.
