The site is comprised of 2 fields which support a rich diversity of species within a mosaic of MG5, U4, MG6, Bracken and Scrub communities. The greatest interest lies in the MG5 and the U4 communities. Species found include <i>Festuca rubra</i>, <i>F. ovina</i>, <i>Anthoxanthum odoratum</i>, <i>Cynosorus cristatus</i>, <i>Danthonia decumbens</i>, <i>Brizia media</i>, <i>Carex caryophyllea</i>, <i>C. flacca</i>, <i>Euphrasia officinalis</i>, <i>Centaurea nigra</i>, <i>Succisa pratensis</i>, <i>Pedicularis sylvatica</i>, <i>Pimpinella saxifrage</i>, <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> and <i>Dactylorhiza fuchsii</i>. Field 2 is MG5 on the slopes, <i>Alchemilla filicaulis</i> is found here. A stream follows the eastern boundary increasing the diversity further. <i>Oenanthe crocata</i>, <i>Rorripe nastutium-aquaticum</i> and <i>Mimulus guttatus</i>.</p> <p>The site is sheltered and surrounded by woodland and semi-improved neutral grassland.
