The MG5 is species rich including Dactylorhiza maculata. Particular interest lies in the marshy grassland (M23a), species include Succisa pratensis, Lotus uliginosus, Lychnis flos-cuculi, Dactylorhiza maculata, Iris pseudacorus and several sedge species.
