Field 1 is lightly grazed, there is a high frequency of <i>Centaurea nigra</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Plantago lanceolata</i> , <i>Stellaria graminea</i> and <i>Trifolium pratense</i> . Field 2 supports the greatest diversity of this site, species here include <i>Dactylorhiza fuchsii</i> , <i>Hypericum maculatum</i> and <i>Centaureum erythraea</i> . Fields 3 and 4 although more heavily grazed at present (3cm), retain a good diversity of species. The fields are sheltered having areas of <i>Rubus fruticosus</i> and <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> scrub. The boundary of the site is dry stone walls with mature trees. The surrounding land is species-rich neutral grassland, woodland and marshy grassland.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
