This field is cut for hay every year and bordered by hedges. It is species-rich, with a woodland in the south and an artificial pond at the bottom of the slope on which the field lies. A damp area with more wetland species can be found here. Throughout the grassland, species include <i>Rhianthus minor</i> , <i>Centaurea nigra</i> , <i>Carex ovalis</i> & <i>Carex nigra</i> . Around the pond are <i>Ranunculus ficaria</i> , <i>Lotus uliginosus</i> , <i>Succisia pratensis</i> and <i>Lychnis flos-cuculi</i> . The other two fields to the west and north are drier, grazed by sheep, and not of WS quality. The site is part of a network of MG5 grasslands in the area, with Whitelye Common to the south.
