The grassland comprises species such as <i>Hypochaeris radicata</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i> & <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i> . There is dominating <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> on the southern edge in particular. Centrally are piles of old grass cuttings. The management is not ideal; the rich grassland remains where it is regularly cut and there is a swing on the northern side. Opposite, near the track, is a new pond which has some non-native species surrounding. A row of tall trees to the west line the back boundary, and are part of the woodland.	H4 Neutral Grassland
