The mire is referable to M25a. Although dominated by Erica tetralix, other species include Calluna vulgaris, Vaccinium myrtilis, Carex laevigata and Carex echinata. There are also two ponds within the mire community. To the northern boundary of the common is a small area of neutral grassland with several spikes of Dactylorhiza fuchsii.
