The meadow is made up of four adjacent meadows enclosed by mature hedgerows that form an important part of the landscape of the area. They lie within the Wye Valley AONB and represent the traditional farming methods once common in this area. To the southwest it is bordered by Fedw Fach, woodland owned by the Forestry Commission Wales. The site is neighboured by a further species-rich field to the north. Please note that survey information is only available for two meadows at this site, these are considered to be representative.
