It is bordered by a fenceline to the south-east, treelines to the south-west and north-east as well as a hedgeline to the north-west. Past these borders lie gardens to the south-east and south-west, improved grassland to the north-east and a track with semi-improved grassland beyond this to the north-west.</p> <p>The first impression of this meadow is very "flowery" as it is a "sea" of Ox-eye Daisy (<i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i>), Common Knapweed (<i>Centaurea nigra</i>) and Catsear/Rough Hawkbit (<i>Hypochaeris</i> <i>radicata</i>/<i>Leontodon hispidus</i>). Birds Foot Trefoil (<i>Lotus corniculatus</i>), Lesser Stitchwort (<i>Stellaria graminea</i>), Yellow Rattle (<i>Rhinanthus minor</i>) and Meadow Vetchling (<i>Lathyrus pratensis</i>) are also frequent constants within the field. The grass sward is composed of a variety of species but is largely quite open only becoming thicker at the edges in the shade of the tree-lines. Bracken is dominant in a narrow band along the north-west edge but is generally not invading the field.</p>	H4) Neutral Grasslands - over 8 indicator species
