Despite the invasion of bracken, fields 2, 3 & 4 retain the MG5 community, species incude Centaurea nigra, Leucanthemum vulgare, Lathyrus pratensis, Lotus corniculatus, Leontodon hispidus and Dactylorhiza fuchsii.
