Field 4 is a hay meadow; Fields 1, 2 and 3 are horse-grazed. <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Hypochaeris radicata</i> , <i>Luzula campestris</i> , <i>Stellaria alsine</i> & <i>Ranunculus bulbosus</i> are found in high frequency, although <i>Centaurea nigra</i> is rare. Field 3 has an area which has an acid influence; species here include <i>Galium saxatile</i> , <i>Veronica officinalis</i> , <i>Rumex acetosella</i> , <i>Dactylorhiza fuchsii</i> & <i>D.maculatum</i> . Field 4, the hay meadow, is particularly colourful, and has a high frequency of <i>Vicia cracca</i> & <i>Stellaria graminea</i> . The fields are fenced and have gappy hedges.	H4 Neutral Grassland
