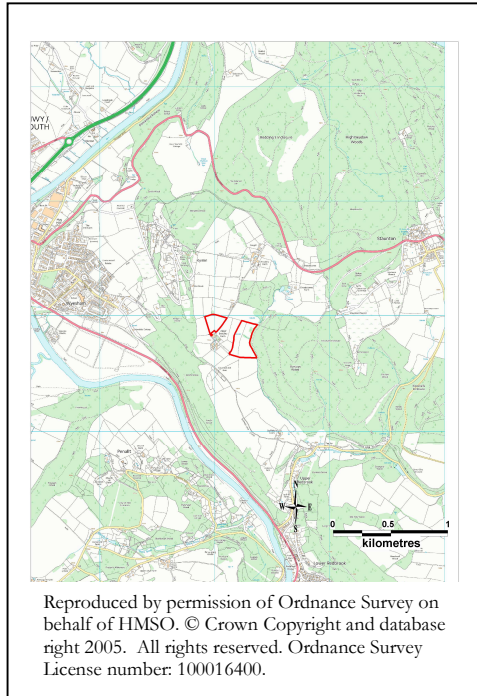

FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE (including topography, adjacent land use, access and boundaries etc.):

A 29 acre farm of which three fields (Hay Meadow, Thistle Field & Lower Field) are considered to be Local Wildlife Site quality: The hay meadow had recently been cut and the hay taken off. Although the hay field had been cut a strip of land with some bracken invasion remained uncut along the lane and fringes of uncut vegetation surrounded the rest of the field. In these uncut areas a range of meadow grasses were apparent along with coarser grasses, False Oat Grass and Cocksfoot. Other plants along these edges included Lesser Stitchwort, Common Sorrel, Hogweed, Cut-leaved Cranesbill, Red and White Clover, Lesser Trefoil, Creeping and Meadow Buttercup, Common Knapweed, Smooth Hawksbeard and an occasional plant of Yellow Rattle. Tufted Vetch was rare along the edge. The presence of these plants especially Lesser Stitchwort, Knapweed and Red Clover, indicate that the hay meadow is species-rich.

In the Thistle field there was an area to the north that was dominated by Creeping Thistles and Nettles, however generally there were numerous ant mounds and an abundance of Bird's-foot Trefoil. Perforate St John's-wort was common, also present were Knapweed, Lesser Stitchwort, Self-heal, Red Clover, Germander Speedwell, Yarrow, Meadow Buttercup and Hairy St John's-wort. Damper areas on spring lines supported Greater Birds-foot Trefoil and Marsh Bedstraw. Bracken and Bramble were encroaching along the eastern side.

The Lower Field had a series of seepages and small streams flowing down the valley sides. Some were within old Alder carr and others in more open grassland. The open seepages were dominated by Fool's Watercress and Water Mint with much Water Figwort, Brooklime Speedwell and Bog Stitchwort. In the Alder carr and along the main stream in the valley bottom, damp woodland plants predominated with species such as Wood Sorrel, Opposite-leaved Golden Saxifrage, Enchanter's Nightshade, Wood Speedwell, Ramsons, Remote Sedge and Hart's-tongue Fern. Some of the Alders along the spring-lines were mature or veteran trees. The open grassland was rich in species with abundant Bird's-foot Trefoil, Knapweed, some Bugle and Glaucous Sedge, patches of Cowslips, and much Field Woodrush, Germander Speedwell, Lesser Stitchwort and Cuckoo Flower.

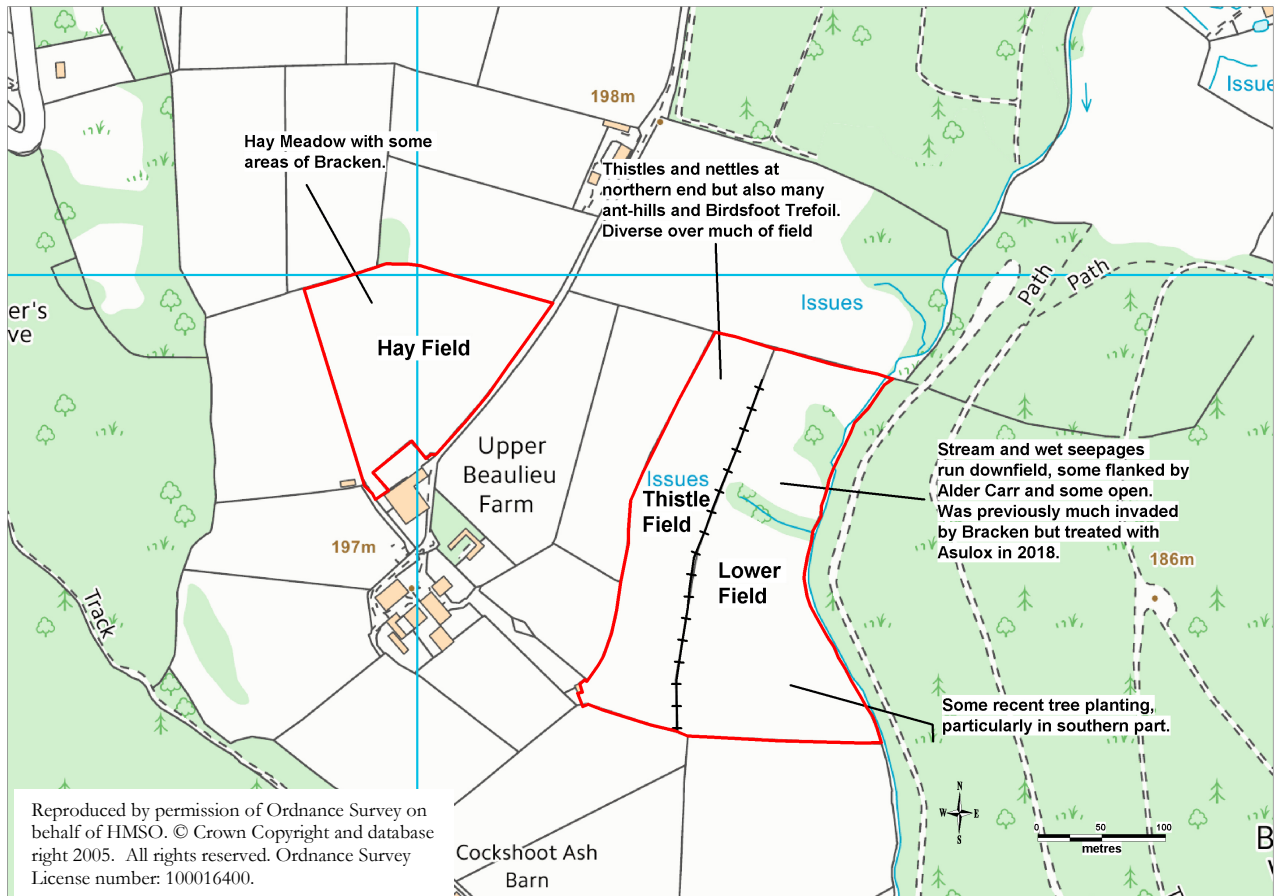
