WS/ST39/03	Little Cwm Dowlais	ST368988	0.57 ha	Semi Improved Neutral Grassland (MG5)	Species Rich Grasslands	The field, which is located to the south-east of Little Cwm Dowlais, supports a small area of species-rich MG5 on steeply sloping ground below a patch of scrub (hawthorn, holly, bramble). Frequent herbs include <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Potentilla erecta</i> , <i>Stachys officinalis</i> & <i>Succisa pratensis</i> . <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i> is occasional. The sward above the scrub is of reduced interest and rather species-poor with <i>Ranunculus repens</i> & <i>Cirsium arvense</i> occasional/frequent, together with <i>Prunella vulgaris</i> , <i>Achillea millefolium</i> & <i>Veronica chamaedrys</i> . Mixed woodland borders the field to the south and banked hedgerows border the east & west (including mature cherry, ash, oak & hazel). The field is unenclosed at the north, lying next to a farm track.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
