The majority of the site comprised flat, slightly rank, damp/wet meadow vegetation, including frequent <i>Juncus effusus</i>, <i>Lotus pedunculatus</i>, <i>Carex hirta</i> and <i>Filipendula ulmaria</i>. Some areas were slightly drier and/or slightly more species-rich, including for example locally occasional <i>Lotus corniculatus</i>, <i>Ranunculus acris</i>, <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> and <i>Succisa pratensis</i>, <i>Carex echinata</i>, <i>Lysimachia nummularia</i>, and <i>Phalaris arundinacea</i>. The majority of the diverse areas were to the east of the reed that runs north-south across the site. A fenced off area of willow scrub is present at the southern end of the field. To the west of the reed, the grassland is semi-improved, typically comprising species such as <i>Ranunculus acris</i>, <i>Deschampsia cespitosa</i>, <i>Alopecurus pratensis</i>, <i>Holcus lanatus</i>, <i>Cynosurus cristatus</i> and locally frequent <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i>.</p>	H4 Neutral Grasslands
